

EDUCATION SECTION BUSINESS MEETING
CLINICAL EDUCATION SECTION BREAKOUT MEETING
ANNUAL CONFERENCE 2004
July 2, 2004

- I. INTRODUCTIONS: Present: Current and Incoming ACCE Co-Chair Peggy Gleeson, Current CCCE Co-Chair Heidi Dunfee, Current Nominating Committee Chair Gina Musolino (present for Education Section Meeting proper), Incoming Membership Secretary Marianne Janssen, and Current Recording Secretary Alecia Thiele Absent: Outgoing Nominating Committee Chair Teri Stumbo, Outgoing Membership Secretary Jenny Rodriguez and Incoming Nominating Committee Member Lynn Frank. Head count attendance included 13 persons.

- II. BRAINSTORMING: The Executive Committee and Clinical Education SIG members discussed the latest issues facing the SIG. The following issues were brought forth and discussed by attendees at the informal Education Section Business Meeting Clinical Education SIG Breakout Session:
 - A. National Clinical Education Conference 2005
 - i. Will be in conjunction with the Academic Administrators Special Interest Group Meeting (AASIG)
 - ii. Location ideas were Houston, TX; Seattle, WA; Alexandria, VA; Southern California and Cruises off the coast of (Galveston, TX). The Northwest Intermountain Consortium Representative (Cyndi Robinson) advocated strongly for a West Coast location. Discussion ensued including the need for clinical community support to the site location, flight ease for air travel, and the AASIG request to determine a location appropriate for all attendees. Ms. Robinson was going to assess the clinical and academic community support for the Seattle region and bring that discussion back to the ACCE and CCCE Co-Chairs for their further discussion with AASIG chairs for site determination.

 - B. CPI Revision: CPI Revision is currently in process. The goal is for implementation of the updated version in 2-3 years. A call to all members in survey form was sent out. This serves as a reminder of members of the section to forward responses to the survey back to the revision members and/or forward the survey to other clinical community for their input on revisions. Also SIG Executive Committee Members were strongly encouraging SIG members familiar with the CPI to train others on proper CPI usage.

 - C. The APTA Consensus Conference on Clinical Education is scheduled in August 2004. The goal is to review the current clinical education

assumptions and challenge the 20 invited clinicians and 10 invited academicians to look to the future of clinical education.

- D. Membership Development: Marianne Janssen the new Membership Secretary inquired about further clinician involvement in the Clinical Education SIG. She volunteered to review the by-laws of the section and possibly look at the ability to allow clinicians of other sections to be allowed to be members of the Clinical Education SIG.
